

Wantsum Sports Association Pavilion

Rules for use of the Bar

1. For the purposes of these rules the terms "bar" and "premises" shall mean the Wantsum Sports Association (WSA) pavilion and bar, Bell Meadow, St Nicholas at Wade. These rules will be effective whenever the bar is open and are additional to the Standard Conditions of Hire of the pavilion.
2. To comply with the conditions of the bar license, whenever the bar is open the WSA pavilion must operate as a private members club.
 - All residents of the villages of St Nicholas at Wade and Sarre are eligible to become members at the discretion of the WSA Committee.
 - Current members of clubs affiliated to the WSA are eligible to be members at the discretion of the WSA Committee.
3. All WSA members will be issued with a Membership Card which must be presented when using the bar or signing in guests. A register of the names and membership numbers of members shall be kept on the premises. Member details for clubs affiliated to the WSA shall be managed by the affiliated clubs, and made available to the WSA.
4. All guests must be signed into the Visitor's Book (which will be kept on the premises for this purpose) by a WSA member when using the bar facilities. Each WSA member may sign in up to five guests at a time. The maximum number of people present in the pavilion at any one time shall not exceed 50.
5. Licensing laws must be obeyed at all times. All persons under 18 must be supervised by a responsible adult and must not be allowed to purchase or consume alcoholic beverages. The premises must be cleared of members and their guests and closed 30 minutes after the conclusion of the last licensed activity.
6. The WSA bar is licensed to serve alcoholic beverages between the times stated below. Actual opening times will be determined by the WSA Committee and affiliated clubs.
 - Monday to Saturday – 10.00am to 11.00pm
 - Sunday, Good Friday and Christmas Day – 12.00 noon to 10.30pm
7. The WSA Committee shall appoint a Bar Manager. Each affiliated club shall appoint one or more Bar Stewards who will be accountable to the Bar Manager.
8. The WSA Committee, Bar Manager and Bar Stewards have the right to refuse entry to the pavilion and/or bar.
9. Where drinks are purchased for consumption on the sports field, these shall be served in non-glass vessels.
10. WSA members are permitted to hire the pavilion and bar for private parties. Arrangements for the opening of the bar shall be agreed at the time of the booking to ensure a WSA Committee volunteer is available to operate the bar. Members of affiliated clubs may make their own arrangements for the bar operation with their appointed Bar Steward(s). There must be no invitation to the public by advertisement. All Rules for use of the Bar apply.
11. All members and guests must be considerate to local residents, and leave the premises and area in a quiet and orderly manner.
